8/14/2022

We heard words from the Grand Sire of the Netherlands Brother Morton Baum. Talked about the lodge they are still trying to start and about the help given to the Ukraine. Also talked about the war orphans in the Ukraine and how they have been getting them placed on other countries for safe keeping. Bills and resolutions were presented and referred to the proper committees. There are a few bills laid over from las session that were also assigned to the proper committees.

Committees set times and places for their meetings later today to go over the work they had been assigned.

A number of resolutions and bills were discussed and acted on. Some bills were withdrawn and others referred to committees for review..
