90th IOOF Pilgrimage to the Tomb of the Unknowns

- The bus departs from the park and ride off exit 45 of the Maine Turnpike on Friday, May 3th at 6:00 AM and returns on Monday, May 6th around 4:30 PM. Picks up and drops off at the Wells bus terminal at exit 19 also, about 6:30 AM, pick-up and drop off at 1-495 rest stop mile 87 Chelmsford MA about 8 to 8:15 A.M. usually stop at Charlton rest area on I-90 for bathroom break and snacks. Next pick-up and drop off location is Nosahogan Odd Fellow Lodge 3200 E. Main St. Waterbury CT about 10:00 A.M. The bus stops about every 2 to 3 hours for bathroom breaks and to get out and walk around. We will stop for a lunch break about noon and should be arriving at the Adams Mark around 5:00 P.M. Be at your departure site a half hour early the bus leaves on time with or without you.
- We would like to get a head count of how many are planning on riding the bus no later than March 20th.
- The cost of the bus will be \$150.00/per person
- If you are planning on riding the bus, please send a deposit of \$75.00 no later than March 20th. Make the check payable to The Grand Lodge of Maine and send to 80 Caron Lane Auburn Maine 04210. Make sure to mark memo section Trip to the Tomb. The remaining funds will be due no later than April 20, 2023.
- You will be responsible for making your own room reservation and for your pre-registration. At the Cemetery you will have to buy a tram ticket for a ride up to the Tomb, also I have been informed that a form of government ID will be required for people 18 and over (e.g. driver's license, state ID, passport etc.) under 18 a student ID is required.
- We can have the bus for up to 15 hours on Saturday and Sunday, so we plan on going out to eat as a group after the wreath laying on Sunday, probably to the Silver Diner in Alexanderia.
- On Saturday if we get enough interest, we may take the bus to the Air and Space Museum at Dulles Airport. Please let me know ASAP so we can arrange it with the bus company.
- On Monday May 6 the bus will depart from the Adams Mark at 6:00 A.M.
- This trip is not restricted to only members of the order anybody can go that wants too.
